- 1. <u>tribe</u> group of people (families, clans, generations) with a common culture
- 2. **arbor** outdoor structure with a roof but no walls
- 3. <u>ribbonwork</u> traditional Osage art of cutting geometric designs in brightly colored ribbons, then sewn on top of each other
- 4. <u>tradition</u> custom, idea or belief passed from older people to younger people
- 5. <u>finger-weaving</u> traditional Osage non-loom weaving of bright yarn
- 6. **clan** sub-group of related people
- 7. **culture** all the beliefs, traditions and social behavior of a group
- 8. **assimilate** changing one's culture to blend into a new culture
- 9. **fluently** To speak a language well, words "flow" easily
- 10. **native** From this place, born here
- 11. **boarding school** Students are sent away from their families to live at a school
- 12. **conversion** change to a new religion
- 13. In-lon-shka most important Osage gathering of the year: dances in June
- 14. **communally** land is jointly owned and shared by everyone no separate ownership
- 15. **suppressed** Put down by authority or force
- 16. **nation** distinct country runs its own government and affairs
- 17. allot to divide up into separate shares or parcels
