1. **Oklahoma** - state where the Osage Reservation is located
2. **constitution** - set of basic ideas that decide how a government is set up
3. **boarding school** - school where children go and live away from their families
4. **native people** - first people; a group of people historically from the place they live
5. **mural** - large painting that is painted directly on a wall
6. **sapling** - small thin (bendable) tree
7. **series** - group of books on related topics
8. **l'n-Lon-Schka** - Osage ceremonial dances centered on the sacred drum
9. **extinct** - when something dies out, no longer exists
10. **sacred** - something that is very special, holy or spiritual
11. **inherit** - when family members die and pass their property to their children
12. **missionaries** - early white people who wanted to convert the Osage to Christianity
13. **reservation** - piece of land on which American Indians were forced to live
14. **arbor** - building with a roof but open on all sides
15. **lineage** - the line of people in your family tree who were your ancestors
16. **allottee** - Osage person who received a ownership share of oil income or land
17. **tradition** - custom, idea or belief passed from older people to younger people
18. **Reign of Terror** - when some cheated or even killed Osage to get their oil income
19. **Siouan** - the language group of the Osage language
20. **headrights** - ownership shares of oil income (an underground mineral interest)
