

## **OSAGE CRADLEBOARD - Review**

## **Questions** Based on "Osage Cradleboard" poster

- A <u>cradleboard</u> is a safe place for a baby to sleep and rest.
- The baby is protected by the <u>bow</u> in front and the padded <u>board</u> behind.
- 3. A <u>sash</u> secures (keeps) the baby on the board.
- 4. What are three things the cloth draped over the bow protects the baby from?

- 5. Osage cradleboards are made of wood.
- 6. What are three things used to decorate the cradleboards?
  (any three) <u>varn (or varnwork)</u> <u>beads (or beadwork)</u> <u>cloth</u> <u>paint</u>
- 7. <u>Bells</u> attached to the bow tinkle softly to comfort the baby.
- (photo caption) Doctors today recommend parents "<u>swaddle</u>" babies, which means wrapping them tightly. This calms them and helps them <u>sleep</u>.
- 9. Native Americans know this, and have used cradleboards for thousands of years.
- 10. What piece of modern baby equipment do you think is most like the cradleboard? (answers vary) carseat, baby carrier, etc.
