ASSIGNMENT: PLAN A HERITAGE SITES ROAD TRIP Plan your own multi-day **Osage Heritage Sites Road Trip** visiting at least **four (4) sites**. Plan from 4 to 8 days. Check off the steps below as you complete them.

STEP ONE: Choose your four sites. Use the list provided in the **HERITAGE SITES FACT SHEET**.

Note: the sites are located in several states of Osage Ancestral Lands. See **Unit B. Osage Ancestral Lands Map**. If you discover other sites which fit the above criteria, include them also.

Record your choices on the provided form: **FOUR SITES RESEARCH NOTES**.

STEP TWO: Conduct research on your four sites - records your notes on the **Four Sites Research Notes form**. For each site, answer these questions:

- Where is it located?
- Why are it important- What is its significance to the Osage culture, and other historic context?
- What activities will you do there - things to do, sites to see?
- How long will you stay there?

Places to find information on sites:

- Individual web sites (if available) for the site
- [Osage News](#) articles - on prior trips to the site - good background
- Tourism/travel sites for four states: Kansas, Oklahoma, Missouri and Arkansas

(Optional - See provided form: **ROAD TRIP BUDGET & SUPPLIES**)

- How much will your trip cost? Research your costs. Establish a maximum budget.
- Adjust your plans to fit your budget.

STEP THREE: Create a ROAD TRIP MAP - linking your home to the four destinations.

- Plan a route to minimize travel - closest ways to link your four sites to each other & home.
- Map the route with a line connecting each destination, and finally returning you home (makes a big circle).
- You can either use software as directed by your teacher, or a hard copy map you might print off from computer.
