

Unit N. Osage News - Additional Activities

Assignment: Write a newspaper story about the Osage News



The "Osage News: Communication Strengthens a Nation" Fact sheet is in Question-and-Answer format, similar to interview questions created by journalists. Assume you are a journalist for a newspaper in another community assigned to write an <u>article about the role and importance of this unique publication - the Osage News.</u> The Fact Sheet is your Q & A notes from an interview. Write a brief story. Just like a real journalist, your space is **limited - 250 words**. You will have to stay focused on your <u>purpose/topic</u> and carefully choose what information to include. Notice sometimes it is harder to write a short story than a longer one.

- 1. Have an attention-getting **lead line** (first sentence)
- 2. Help guide the reader through the logic of your piece i.e. use **transitions** such as *For example, In addition, In contrast, As a result,* etc.
- 3. Have two or three **quotes** the Fact Sheet; for the **tag line** on these, put "According to an *Osage News* staff-person, ..."
- Remember when you write, how do we format the title of a publication? We put it in italics i.e. Osage News.
- 5. Start by choosing facts/phrases you think are **most important**.
- 6. Organize those facts in **logical order**
- Then combine them into sentences: pack as much information as you can into your
 250-word article by combining facts and phrases into more complex, varied, fluent
 sentences
